In order to furnish his summer home in Ibiza, thanks to the rationalist skill of Germán Rodríguez Arias – who was also Pablo Neruda's architect on the refurbishments of his house on Black Island, the founder of GATEPAC and consequently a partner by attachment of Torres Clavé, Sert, Illescas and other champions of the modern movement in Spain – this lounge chair benefits from an uninterrupted steel tube structure that generously holds the lower seat and the deep backrest that are conducive to conversation. It is extremely comfortable and has a highly colourful appearance, suited for use in public and private settings.
