


Responsibility vs. Sustainability

We strive to create a positive impact on our natural surroundings at both local and global levels.





72% of our suppliers are within <150km of our headquarters. Nevertheless, the search for new techniques and experiences leads us to collaborate with artisans from around the world.




Industrial craftsmanship

We invest in renewable energy. Today, we produce 24% of the consumed energy.




Responsible water management

We lay out our strategy and results before your eyes. Aware that the path ahead is long, it will find us endeavouring with continuous effort.


